

ELIGIBILITY CHECKLIST

- Incoming or ongoing college student taking a course in Education with a specialization in STEM-related fields, Technical Vocational Program, or General Education
- No failed, dropped, or incomplete grades in the previous academic year.
- Enrolled or intend to enroll in a TEI with LET performance above the national average.
- Have a GWA of at least 85% or its equivalent from the previous academic year
- Must be of good moral standing with no existing disciplinary case
- Involved in extracurricular or community activities; willing to teach in a public school in their community after graduation
- In need of financial support to complete studies and preferably not a recipient of other scholarships
- Must be in good health
